## **Colin McGuirk** BDS, MSc (Implants), MClinDent (Prosth)

After graduating from Newcastle University Colin completed extensive postgraduate training, including two masters degrees; a MSc in dental implantology and a MClinDent in fixed and removable prosthodontics and he was awarded a distinction for both degrees. Colin's practice is limited to adhesive dentistry, prosthodontics and dental implantology in a private referral practice in Bath. Colin is involved in teaching dentists as part of MSc/MClinDent programmes, and through independent courses across the UK.



## **Contemporary restoration of root canal treated teeth**

Colin will focus on the different aspects of post-endodontic restorations from post and core build-ups to cuspal coverage restorations with particular emphasis on adhesive techniques.

Dipti graduated from King's College London. She completed her specialist training in Endodontics at the UCL Eastman Dental Institute with distinction, becoming a registered "Specialist in Endodontics" in 2015. Dipti has carried out high quality research on the clinical outcome of endodontic surgery, for which she was awarded a national prize from the British Endodontic Society.

Dipti also works as an Honorary Clinical Teaching Fellow at the Eastman Dental Institute, where she is involved in the clinical and academic teaching of specialists in training.
